HUNTERS:

Novice Freshman Junior Varsity Varsity

Novice Hunters: Fences will be set at 2' with no oxers. Competitors cannot be in this if they have competed at the 2'3" level.

Freshman Hunters: Fences will be set a 2'3". Medal fences will be set 2'6". Competitors cannot be in this division if they have competed at the 2'9" level.

Junior Varsity Hunters: Fences will be set at 2'9". Medal fences will be set at 3'. Competitors cannot be in this division if they have competed at the 3'3" level.

Varsity Hunters: Open to riders who are competent to show over Hunter and Equitation courses with fences at 3'3". Medal fences will be set at 3'3" to 3'6"

JUMPERS:

Junior Varsity Varsity

Junior Varsity Jumper fences will be set at 3' - .90m. Cannot have competed at the 3'6 level

Varsity Jumper fences will be set at 3'3" - 1.0m.

WESTERN:

Walk/Jog Novice Limit Gymkhana

Walk/Jog: Open to riders who have NOT shown at the lope at any recognized show.

Novice: Open to riders who have not won more than 3 blue ribbons at a recognized show including IEL.

DRESSAGE:

Novice Freshman Junior Varsity Varsity

Competitors cannot compete in any class in which they have won the SIESL Year-End Champion or Reserve Champion.
